



HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

The Academy Schools within Chancery Education Trust take pride in inspiring all learners to achieve their very best within a happy community where respect and tolerance for self and others is embedded. We believe that when parents and the Academy School agree to work together, there is a positive impact on the children's development. We are children and adults learning together!

The Academy School will aim to:

- Contact parents/carers if there is a concern about attendance, punctuality, academic work, behaviour or general well-being.
- Respond to communications within five working days, allowing staff to give appropriate consideration to messages, while maintaining their core responsibilities to teaching, learning, and pupil welfare.
- Send home an annual school report.
- Arrange parents'/carers' evenings during which progress will be discussed.
- Keep parents informed about Academy School activities through regular letters home, news sheets and notices about special events.
- Inform parents about what the teachers aim to teach the children each term.
- Academy School staff will be role models for pupils, modelling the John Wood School & Nursery Core Values daily.
- Encourage all children to do their best at all times.
- Encourage all children to take care of other people in the Academy School, and also to take care of their surroundings.
- Care for the children's safety and happiness and ensure that they have the opportunity to achieve their full potential as valued members of the school community.
- Provide a balanced curriculum and meet the individual needs of our pupils.
- Have expectations of high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility.
- Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the Academy School.
- Ensure that the children are able to work in an e-safe environment when using ICT equipment
- Provide remote learning that is accessible to all in the event of a pandemic; providing quality learning opportunities and feedback from teaching staff on progress.

The parent/carer will aim to:

- Ensure their child arrives at John Wood School & Nursery Academy on time, between 8:40 and 8:55am, and be properly equipped.
- Inform the Academy School of the reasons for their child's absence via Arbor or email: absence@johnwood.cetrust.com
- Let the Academy School know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Support the Academy School's policies and guidelines for behaviour.
- Actively support their child with homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- Attend parents/carers evenings and discussions about their child's progress.
- Ensure their child wears the full school uniform and sensible shoes.
- Ensure their child does not bring a Smartphone to the Academy School
- Support their child in using ICT safely and securely.
- Understand that should an extra-curricular club be cancelled, they are to collect their child when requested
- Support their child/ren with remote learning during any periods of class/school closure or self-isolation in the event of a pandemic.
- Ensure all remote learning is undertaken as per the Academy School's recommendation.
- Support your child in understanding the John Wood Core Values.
- Support your child in following the Academy School Golden Rules.
